Participants gain the ability to implement a legally defensible "Day Zero" to "Operational Intensive" pipeline, ensuring their teams can safely interdict threats, coordinate seamlessly with federal partners, and preserve critical digital evidence using forensic principles. By attending, leadership replaces agency liability with mission readiness, protecting their personnel and their prosecutions from the operational and legal risks of the modern drone landscape.

This intensive UAS and UAS Countermeasures program is designed for command-level leadership including Chiefs, Sheriffs, and Base Commanders along with the specialized Law Enforcement, DoD, and Critical Infrastructure units responsible for securing our most sensitive sites.



THE COURSE

This comprehensive program transitions personnel from foundational awareness to advanced operational mastery. It is structured to ensure that every graduate from patrol officer to command staff operates within a legally defensible framework while maintaining technical and tactical superiority in the airspace.

COURSE STRUCTURE

Phase I: Day Zero C-UAS Foundations (8 Hours)

- UAS 101: Exploration of drone types, payloads, and evolving threat profiles (surveillance vs. swarms).
- Airspace Essentials: Understanding FAA regulations, Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFRs), and identifying hostile vs. lawful operations.
- C-UAS Fundamentals: Introduction to the legal boundaries of detection, tracking, and identification.
- Practical Application: Hands-on drone ID exercises and tabletop simulations.

Phase II: Counter-UAS Operational Course (24 Hours / 3 Days)

- Legal Authority: Mastery of federal preemption and operating decisively within FAA lanes.
- The C-UAS Kill Chain: Detailed execution of the Detect → Track → Identify → Mitigate cycle, focusing on operator interdiction.
- Advanced Sensor Fusion: Integrating RF, radar, acoustic, and EO/IR data into a Unified Operational Picture (UOP).
- Forensic Integrity: Application of forensic principles for the preservation of volatile digital evidence and chain of custody.
- Scenario-Based Training: High-pressure decision-making for critical infrastructure and mass-gathering events.

This training equips participants with the specialized expertise required to analyze complex airspace threats and execute legally defensible responses under high-pressure conditions. Graduates will master the entire C-UAS kill chain while ensuring all actions remain within FAA and federal legal boundaries. Students will be proficient in managing interagency communications, preserving critical digital evidence, and will be able to effectively transforming operational risk into a coordinated, mission-ready capability.
